The Antall József Knowledge Centre (AJKC) is organising the 6th instalment of the Young Leaders' Forum (YLF) to be held on 11-13 October 2021. YLF is a side event of think.BDPST, Hungary's strategic conference on regional development and the perspectives of research, innovation, and future technologies.

Young professionals (aged 24-38) ready to shape the future and drive positive changes in the field of innovation are welcome to apply. YLF connects experts from the fields of social sciences, natural sciences, and legal studies to create a bridge between these fields and help young decision makers to make their innovations more effective and successful.

The programme of YLF 2021 focusses on issues connected to e-Governance, digitalisation, and renewable/green energy. There are two main topics to be discussed in different formats during the forum: security challenges related to e-Governance and green energy developments in the V4 region.

During the Forum, participants will have the opportunity to:

- Exchange ideas and discuss innovative initiatives
- Develop their leadership competencies
- Learn new skills to become more competitive in their respective fields
- Create a global community with the vision, courage, and motivation to drive positive changes and innovation together

Full and partial scholarships are available for Hungarian and foreign nationals coming from the V4 countries and the EU. Full scholarships cover accommodation with breakfast in Budapest and international direct travel costs. Lunch will be available for all participants. The different types of scholarships will be awarded according to the candidates' competencies, professional achievements, and educational background. For participants of Hungarian or foreign nationality residing in Budapest, the scholarship does not automatically include breakfast and accommodation. For those candidates applying from Hungary who do not reside in Budapest, accommodation will be available, and travel costs within Hungary will be covered.

All selected participants will attend the think.BDPST conference to be held on 14 October 2021.
