KREative Writing Workshop

The self-organized student workshop coordinated by Katalin G. Kállay Associate Professor at the Institute of English Studies of Károli Gáspár University was started by a number of enthusiastic students in 2014, inspired by the course "Introduction to Literary Studies", who expressed their desire for a forum where they can present and discuss their creative works (both poetry and fiction) in English. We have had regular monthly online meetings, and the student works were first published in a self-made style, in a booklet entitled *So Much Depends Upon*. In 2016, thanks to a NTP support, the book entitled *This Is Just to Say* was published in the Károli Books Series by L'Harmattan Publishing House, which contains creative as well as academic works by 50 students, who participated in the illustration and the editing job of the volume as well. Our third home-made publication, *Unfolding Stories* appeared for the celebration of our tenth anniversary, in 2024. It is already a tradition that the students publicly present their works at the Christmas Party of the Institute of English Studies and they organize a public meeting at the Training Week. In 2020, the online workshop meeting was recorded on October 20, as a Training Week event, with 100 participants. The recording can be found at the following link:
