## **ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENT**

Exchange students are required to submit an official language certificate, and we ask our partners to ensure students have one of the following before submitting the nomination:

• IELTS: minimum of 5.5 with no bands less than 5.5

iBT TOEFL: minimum of 70Cambridge English: B2

Duolingo: minimum score of 100
