Dongguk University ◦ Undergraduate Exchange students can take major <i>except for</i> 'College of Pharmacy', 'College of Future Convergence' and Department of Korean Music, Department of Theatre, Department of Sport Culture at College of Arts. ◦ Graduate Exchange Students can only apply for 'Graduate Schools 研究生院'. ※ Applicants from special (professional) graduate(特殊研究院) schools are not eligible. ◦ Please be advised that all classes of 'Life science and Biotechnology College' are taught at 'Ilsean Campus' located in Gyeonggi Province. ◦ Since most of the graduate courses are delivered in Korean, graduate students who wish to participate in the exchange program can choose an undergraduate course in English. ◦ Students can choose courses such as taught in Korean, English, Chinese etc. within <u>18</u> credits per semester. (Graduate Students can choose up to <u>9</u> credits) ※ A minimum of two(2) courses is required for graduate students. ◦ Please refer to the course list on <i>Sheet 2 for Fall semester 2025</i>. ◦ DU provides courses for International students such as 'Foreign students only(国际学生专用)'. Required Insurance	① Exchange students are required to submit their Home country insurance as an application document for the exchange program. This should include Accidental Injury Medical Treatment Insurance and Hospitalization Medical Insurance upon their arrival. (It should cover all periods of stay in Korea) ② Also, all international Students (Including exchange students) staying in Korea are subject to a mandatory subscription to National Health Insurance(NHIS). Both are required - Once the residence card (외국인등록증) has been issued, The NHIS payment notice will be sent to each student's registered address directly. - Monthly payment for exchange student is around KRW 80,000. Details will be announced with the payment notice.
