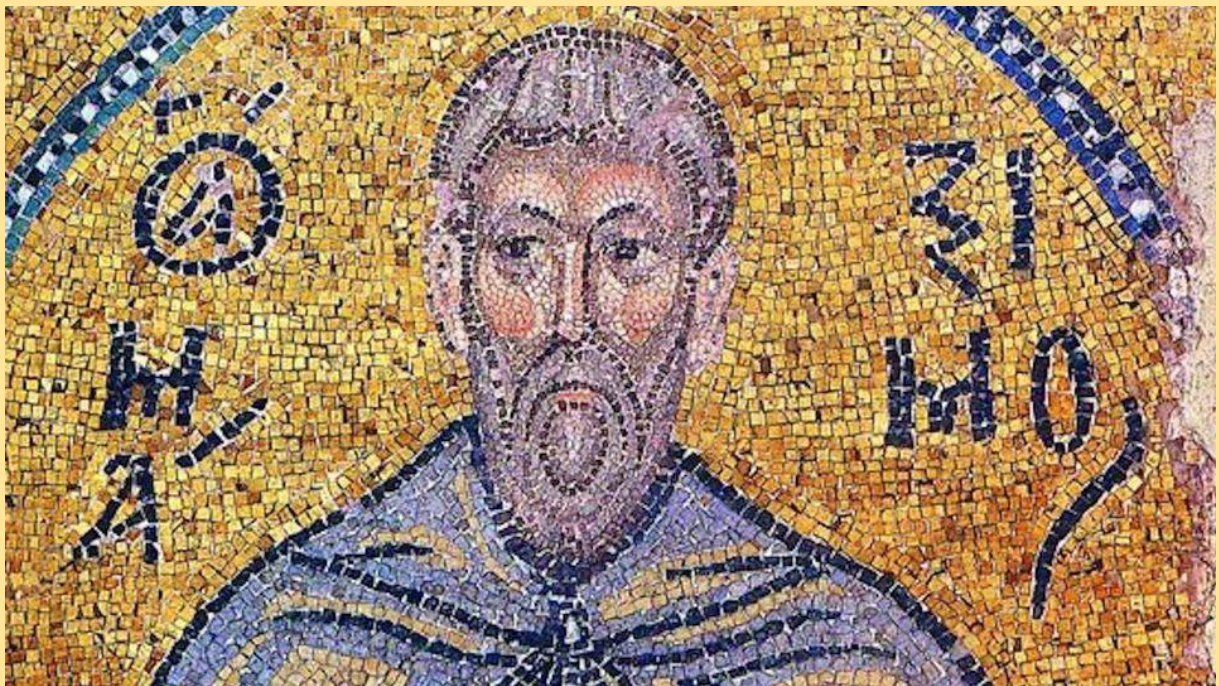


International Colloquium on Saint Maximus the Confessor's
